
Administrative Costs

- Interactions between providers and insurance is a major cost (\$31 billion)¹
- Interactions include gaining prior authorization, working with formularies for medication, processing insurance claims, maintaining their credentials and contracting prices with a multitude of insurers.² High degree of variance.
- \$68,274 per physician per year²
- Value added to quality of care?

Administrative Costs Single-payer vs. Multi-payer System

- Lower interaction variance in Singlepayer system, such as National Health Insurance in Canada¹
- US spends \$82,975 per physician per year, other overhead costs considered¹
- Canada spends \$22,205 per physician per year¹
- Δ \$60,000 per year per physician

Administrative Complexity & Muda

- Admin complexity defined as waste resulting from imprudent processes³
- 34% of healthcare expenditure is waste³
- 50% of Administrative Costs are waste⁴
- 31% of total waste is admin complexity (up to \$389 billion / year)³
- \$183 billion per year in Billing & Insurance-Related (BIR) waste⁵

Admin Hours per Week per Physician²

- Physicians: 3 hours per week
- Nursing Staff: 19.1 hours per week
- Clerical Staff: 35.9 per week

Admin Hours per Week by Specialty²

- Primary Care: 3.5 hours per week
- Specialists: 2.6 hours per week
- Surgeons: 2.1 hours per week
